Qualifications:

Intro to PrePower –

Skaters typically age 4-7 years of age currently enrolled in the Hockey/Ringette Canada Initiation/Development Level Programming. This is a skating only program to assist young skaters develop basic skating fundamentals at a young age and progress into our National Pre-Power and CanPower Programs. The Skate Canada Pre/CanPower Programs are the only Nationally recognised powerskating programs of their kind and all coaching staff on the sessions must be NCCP Certified CanPower Coaches.

Participation in the Intro Program will provide a solid base for participants to move into:

Pre-Power -

Skaters must have Canskate Badge 3 or equivalent. This program is for those young hockey or ringette players who are not yet qualified for the Canpower programs. Full hockey equipment is mandatory.

Canpower –

Skaters must have achieved a minimum Canskate Badge 4 and have played a minimum of one year of organized hockey or ringette. Canpower Level 1-6 skaters are welcome. Full hockey equipment is mandatory.

Registration Policy:

Skaters will be notified following their registration only if there is a change to the time requested in their application. Skaters must register for the program for which they are qualified for at the time of registration. GSC reserves the right to move skaters between levels depending upon the skater’s abilities. The GSC also has the right to change the skaters’ ice times depending upon numbers of registrations received or to cancel hours if registration is insufficient.
