Qualifications:

Pre-Power- Skaters must have Canskate Badge 3 or equivalent. This program is for those young hockey or ringette players who are not yet qualified for the Canpower programs. Full hockey equipment is mandatory.

Canpower – Skaters must have achieved a minimum Canskate Badge 4 and have played a minimum of one year of organized hockey or ringette. Canpower Level 1-6 skaters are welcome. Full hockey equipment is mandatory.

Registration Policy:

Skaters will be notified following their registration only if there is a change to the time requested in their application. Skaters must register for the program for which they are qualified for at the time of registration. GSC reserves the right to move skaters between levels depending upon the skater's abilities. The GSC also has the right to change the skaters' ice times depending upon numbers of registrations received or to cancel hours if registration is insufficient.

Payment and Refund Policy:

Cheques must be made payable to the Goulbourn Skating Club. NSF cheques will be subject to a \$25 administration fee.

No refunds will be given after **October 1st, 2010** unless accompanied by a medical certificate.
