SYNCHRO: Juvenile or Pre Novice Festival Synchro Team. Minimum requirements are CanSkate Stage 6 badge or strong skating skills. Enjoy friends and fun while skating to music as a synchronized team.

NOTE: **Synchro starts Saturday, September 8, 2007. Mandatory Synchro conditioning/training camp and try-outs held September 8 – September 29, 2007 Sign up if you want to join the synchro team! Regular synchro starts October 3, 2007 and runs to March 26, 2008 for those who attend the mandatory session and are selected. A separate registration will take place for the Winter Program (refer to Club website for details.)**

Registration Policy: Skaters will be notified following their registration only if there is a change to the times requested in their application. Skaters must register in the category for which they are qualified at the time of registration. If you wish to move to a different session you must complete a "Move Request" form (see "Policies" on website) and submit it for approval to Registrar. GSC reserves the right to move skaters between levels depending upon the skaters' abilities. The GSC also has the right to change the skaters' ice times depending upon numbers of registrations received or to cancel hours if registration is insufficient.

Note: Non-Goulbourn coaches wishing to coach their skaters must request permission from the Goulbourn Executive in writing before the beginning of the session.

Payment and Refund Policy: Cheques must be made payable to the **Goulbourn Skating Club** dated for the registration date. NSF cheques will be subject to a \$25 administration fee. No refunds will be given after **August 24th, 2007** unless accompanied by a medical certificate.

Late Registration: All registrations must be received by **August 13th, 2007**. Please add **\$25** for any forms to be received after **August 13th, 2007**.

Test Qualifications:

Senior: Skater has passed the complete Junior Bronze Freeskate test or two complete Senior bronze tests.

Intermediate: Skater has not passed the complete Junior Bronze Freeskate test.

A letter of permission from your Home Club President or Test Chair must accompany applications from non-Goulbourn skaters.
