Welcome to the Goulbourn Skating Club's ("GSC") Fall CanPower Program. Please read the following information carefully for registration information and skate times. If you have any questions that are not answered in this information package, please feel free to call one of the numbers above.

Location: Stittsville Community Centre

Schedule: Tuesdays and Thursdays (Mandatory Two Sessions/Week)

Times: 5-6 pm / 6-7 pm / 7-8 pm

Cost: \$150.00 (this includes 5.6% increase from last year.)

Fall Registration Date: August 13th, 2007 from 7:00-9:00 pm at the Stittsville Community Centre

Qualifications:

Skaters must have played a minimum of one year of organized hockey or ringette. Levels 1 to 6 skaters are welcome. Full hockey equipment is required.

Canpower Levels: Level 1-6: Bronze, Silver, Gold

Registration Policy:

"First Come, First Served" basis. "In Person" registration only, no mail-in registrations allowed.

Skaters will be notified following their registration only if there is a change to the times requested in their application. Skaters must register in the category for which they are qualified at the time of registration. GSC reserves the right to move skaters between levels depending upon the skaters' abilities. The GSC also has the right to change the skaters' ice times depending upon numbers of registrations received or to cancel hours if registration is insufficient.

NOTE: We always have more registrations than we can accommodate, so register early!!

Payment and Refund Policy:

Cheques must be made payable to the **Goulbourn Skating Club** dated for the registration date. NSF cheques will be subject to a \$25 administration fee. No refunds will be given after **August 24th, 2007** unless accompanied by a medical certificate. You are welcome to take advantage of a \$10 discount per second and subsequent skaters if you are registering more than one skater in your family.

Late Registration:

All registrations must be received by **August 13th, 2007**. Any vacancies will be filled from waiting list of applicants in the order they are received.
